

Track & Trace

As part of the government's roadmap for reopening the leisure industry, all health clubs are legally required to keep a register of all users for up to 21 days and provide data to NHS Test & Trace if requested.

The King's Club has a legal obligation to display the Club's QR code at the main reception. Members and visitors to the Club are asked to download the NHS Test & Trace App on their phones and check in on arrival. This App is not yet a legal requirement but members and visitors are encouraged to use this "App" on arrival.

Legal Requirement

It is a legal requirement for the King's Club to keep data of all visitors / members of the club for up to 21 days, therefore members are legally required to produce the following on arrival:

- Membership cards to be produced on arrival.
- Members will be asked to have their photo taken on arrival which will be attached to their member record to verify their identity.
- If for any reason a member refuses to have their photo taken for our records, then photo ID must be produced alongside the membership card to validate identity.
