

## KING'S CLUB BADMINTON - MEMBER BOOKINGS / CASUAL BADMINTON

The guidance below sets out how the game can be played by members and their guests given the current restrictions. Please note these guidelines are from Badminton England as of 10<sup>th</sup> September in alignment with Government guidance. Members will be informed if the guidance changes.

### GENERAL

- Singles and doubles play can take place in groups of people from different households, providing they remain 2 metres apart as far as possible.
- Singles and doubles can be played using all areas of the court, within the respective court markings – if social distancing between adjacent courts cannot be maintained, players should only use the singles court markings.
- Players are not to change ends.
- Players are advised to limit their interactions with anyone outside of the group they are playing in (e.g. players in another group)
- Other than where players are from the same household or part of a support bubble, follow Government advice on staying alert and safe, and:
  - Stay at least two metres away from other players (including during play) as much as possible, when taking breaks and before and after play.
  - Do not make physical contact with other players (such as shaking hands or high fiving)

### Badminton Rules

- **To book a court** – members can call the club reception during opening hours and book up to 4 days in advance. Members can book two different days per call. Tel: 0208 255 5404.
- **Court fee** – a court fee of £10 will be charged at the point of booking.
- **Guests** – the club is for members only, however a member may invite one guest to play badminton. The member must register the guest's details at the point of booking and pay the £10 guest fee. The guest is only permitted to play badminton and not to use any other part of the club. The guest must present their identification on arrival
- **Equipment** – the club will set up the badminton nets and will have shuttle cocks available to purchase. The club is not able to hire out any equipment and members must not share rackets.
- **Sharing of shuttles** – players are reminded to have thoroughly wash their hands (in accordance with Government guidance) or use hand sanitiser immediately before and after play.
- **Equipment bags** – are to be stored behind players playing court and at least 2 metres from the back of the court and any other players.
